Before you use online navigation connected services

1. For all online navigation connected services, the first step is to ensure that your car has internet access.

One method of connecting is using Bluetooth tethering.



2. Ensure that you have activated online navigation connected services, by entering your MyT app/My Toyota credentials into the multimedia system.


Using online navigation connected services: Step 1

Click on “Map”.




Using online navigation connected services: Step 2

Using online navigation connected services: Step 3


Enter your destination.



Using online navigation connected services: Step 4


Here you can find:

If you click on parking...




Using online navigation connected services: Parking

You can view the parking facilities:


- Nearby your current location

By selecting the relevant tab.





You can then display the parking facilities by distance...




Using online navigation connected services: Parking

...by company...





If you click on Google Street View...




Using online navigation connected services: Google Street View

...you will see what your destination looks like.


By clicking on the arrows you can see a 360° view.

Using online navigation connected services: Weather


If you click on Weather...



Using online navigation connected services: Weather


...you can see the current weather and the forecast for your destination.

You can also choose an alternative location by clicking on “Location”.




Using online navigation connected services: Weather

You can then select which location you would like to view the weather for.




Using online navigation connected services: Traffic information

When navigation guidance is set-up, you can see real time traffic information on the right hand side of the screen.




Using online navigation connected services: Traffic information

Click on “...”




Using online navigation connected services

Click on “Traffic”.




Using online navigation connected services: Traffic information

You can view the main traffic information for your journey.




Using online navigation connected services: Traffic information

At any time click on “Fuel” to find fuel stations.




Using online navigation connected services: Fuel

By selecting the relevant tab.




Using online navigation connected services: Fuel

You can then display the fuel stations by distance...




Using online navigation connected services: Fuel


...or by price.



Using online navigation connected services: Cyclops speed camera alerts


The map displays the location of speed and traffic light cameras.

To signal a non-registered camera, click directly on the camera icon




Using online navigation connected services: Cyclops speed camera alerts
